

The Virginia Beach Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) serves in an advisory capacity to the School Board on issues related to the education of students with disabilities. The committee assists in the formulation and development of priorities and strategies for meeting the identified needs of students with disabilities. SEAC also submits periodic reports and recommendations to the School Board regarding the education of students with disabilities.

The SEAC committee is composed of people with disabilities, parents or family members of students with disabilities, representatives from public agencies concerned with the care of people with disabilities, and local school personnel who serve as consultants to the committee.

Meetings are held on the second Monday of each month. You may check with the Office of Programs for Exceptional Children (OPEC), 263- 2400, for the time and location. We welcome guests to attend our meetings as well as make public comment on issues they believe to be important in the education of students with disabilities in our city.
